We will have a report on DIBELS next meeting when all grades are done with them.

Brooklyn talked about the Invention Report.

- 132 kids are receiving reading intervention
- Brooklyn broke down the number of kids in each grade that have not made significant gains(more then 10%)
 - 5th grade only 6 of 30 have not made significant gains
 - 4th grade only 5 of 24 have not made significant gains
 - 3rd grade only 4 of 30 have not made significant gains
 - 2nd grade only 6 of 30 have not made significant gains
 - 1st. grade only 2 of 29 have not made significant gains
- They checked to see if there was a reoccurring reason for these students not making gains. They checked what teacher, class and read specialist each student had. There was nothing that was reoccurring.
- 1st of the year we had 66.6% of students on grade level for reading. With these the interventions that have been made our school is now up to 74.2 %
- We should see big payoffs in the 2nd year.
